Lom Wong

Celebrating the cultures and recipes of Thailand, Yotaka "Sunny" and Alex Martin opened the beloved Lom Wong in 2019, making it their goal to share the unique regional dishes they knew and loved. Lom Wong's mission is to be sincere to the ingredients, techniques and service styles that are found in the Thai villages that inspired the restaurant. Lom Wong – The Documentary was released in October 2021, highlighting the days when Sunny and Alex ran weekly pop-ups before their brick-and-mortar opened in early 2022 and sharing the stories of the friends and family who inspired these recipes. Lom Wong has drawn attention nationwide, with a feature in the New York Times in 2022 and a nomination for the James Beard Award's Best Chef of the Southwest in 2023.

Pizzeria Bianco



Now the chef-owner of Pizzeria Bianco, with two locations in Phoenix, Arizona, along with two Pane Bianco restaurants. Bianco's white-tablecloth restaurant Tratto, also in Phoenix, features handmade pastas and seasonal favorites with mainly local ingredients from artisans and farmers.

Newly remodeled rooms that were once the private quarters of the Wrigley family are available for private dining.
